MINNEAPOLIS - The Center for Energy and Environment, an independent, non-profit organization that works to promote the responsible and efficient use of natural and economic resources has been selected as the independent commissioning agent for two ISD #270 Hopkins Public Schools projects.

Hopkins Public Schools is preparing for additions and remodeling to the Hopkins High School and Eisenhower Elementary School/Eisenhower Community Center. These two projects will be commissioned using the ASHRAE commissioning process modified by the requirements of the Minnesota Department of Children, Families, and Learning as well as the diagnostics-intensive style of CEE. The process has begun with a review of the Hallberg and Associates design (now in process) and will continue throughout construction and to the end of the warranty period.
