Program Overview

- All new homes are eligible for a maximum of \$6,000 in rebates per home.
- Eligible homes must be on tribal land and can either be newly built site-built homes or newly manufactured homes
- Members pursuing the whole home rebates must coordinate with CEE before applying for the rebate. Work with CEE before purchasing your home to ensure it complies with these standards.
- Once your rebate form is approved, PIIC will mail you a rebate check.
