Program Overview and Eligibility

- Site-built homes are considered new if they were built on or after 9/1/2024.
- Manufactured homes are considered new if they were purchased on or after 9/1/2024.
- All new homes are eligible for a maximum of \$6,000 in rebates per home. Rebate amounts and requirements are on the next page.
- Eligible homes must be on Tribal land and can either be newly built site-built homes or newly manufactured homes.
- Members pursuing the **whole home rebates must work with CEE before purchasing or designing your home and applying for the rebate**. Additional details are below.
- Once your rebate form is approved, PIIC will mail you a rebate check.

EnergyWise Rebate Amounts and Requirements

Whole Home Certification Rebates

Be energy efficiency from the start when you purchase or design a new manufactured or site-built home to one of the following Whole Home standards. To qualify for either one, you **must** work with the [New Construction](#) team at CEE from early on in your construction and design process. Paperwork proving your home is eligible for one of these certifications may vary, which is why it's best to work with CEE early in the process. Physical inspection of the new home is also a requirement for certification. For newly built manufactured homes, this may include an inspection at the facility where the home is built.

For these certifications, please note:

- You must contact CEE's New Construction team early in the process to talk through the requirements and do preliminary energy modeling.
- There will be two or three mid-point inspections of your home.
- You will need to provide final certification reports to earn this certification.

Whole Home Certifications for New Homes	Rebate
ENERGY STAR® certified site-built homes or manufactured homes	\$6,000
Department of Energy Efficient New Homes Program	\$6,000

If the Whole Home Certificate is earned, the home is **not** eligible to receive the project-based rebates. Members may reach out the [New Homes team](#) at Center for Energy and Environment (CEE) for assistance earning these certificates.

You can also save energy and money by selecting one, some, or all the following energy efficiency equipment items for your home, earning the corresponding rebate listed.
